STATUTORY LIST OF PUBLIC ROADS – KIRKTON GARDENS, FRASERBURGH

1 Recommendations

1.1 It is recommended that the Committee

Approve the roads and footways listed in Appendix 1 for addition to the Statutory List of Public Roads.

2 Background / Discussion

- 2.1 As Roads Authority, Aberdeenshire Council is required to add roads and footways which have been completed to an acceptable standard to the Statutory List of Public Roads under the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.
- 2.2 The roads and footways associated with this report are listed in the attached schedule “Additions to the Statutory List of Public Roads” (Appendix 1) and on the attached plan (Appendix 2).
- 2.3 The roads and footways have been completed to a satisfactory standard and are acceptable for adoption.
- 2.4 The Head of Finance and the Monitoring Officer within Business Services have been consulted and have no comments to make.

3 Equalities, Staffing and Financial Implications

- 3.1 An equality impact assessment is not required because the recommended actions don't have a differential impact on people with protected characteristics.
- 3.2 There are no staffing implications associated with this report.

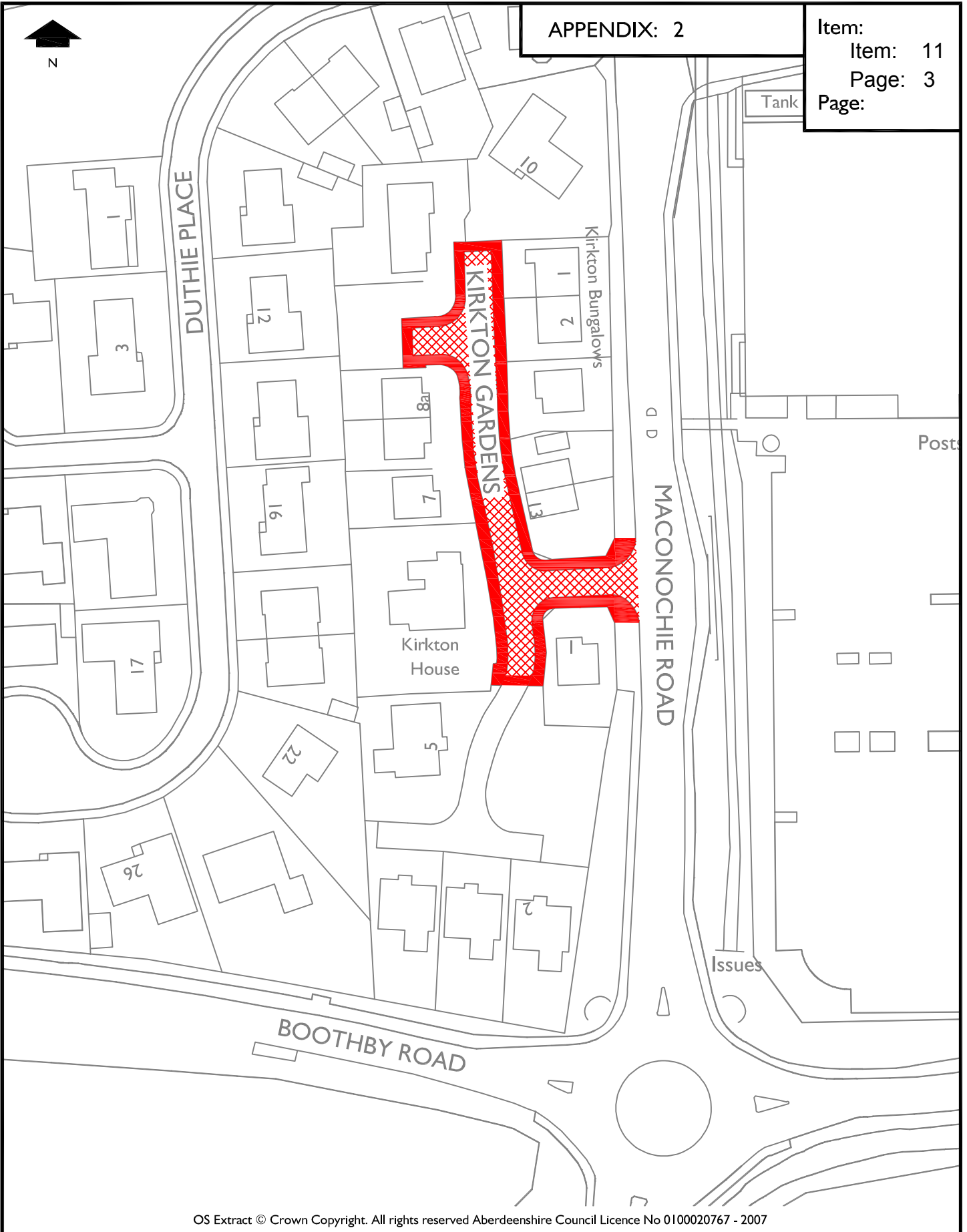
