USE OF DELEGATED POWERS BY OFFICERS BY REASON OF SPECIAL URGENCY

1 Recommendations

The Council is recommended to note the occasions when officers have used delegated powers (as provided in the List of Powers Delegated to Officers, paragraph A18), to take decisions by reason of special urgency.

2 Background

- 2.1 The Council at its meeting on 28 November, 2013 (Item 7, Page 780), approved an amendment to the List of Powers Delegated to Officers in relation to procedures for making decisions in situations of urgency and requested that information be circulated to members annually detailing how often this delegated power was used.
- 2.2 Since January 2014, there have been nine occasions when officers have used this delegated power. These are listed in the appendix to this report.
- 2.3 The Head of Finance and Monitoring Officer within Business Services have been consulted in the preparation of this report and had no comments.
