

REPORT TO FORMARTINE AREA COMMITTEE – 28 June 2016

STREET NAMING – HAREBURN TERRACE, BLACKDOG DEVELOPMENT

1 Recommendations

- 1.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the name 'Booth Gardens' for the new street within the above development.

2 Background / Discussion

- 2.1 A new housing development is proposed in Hareburn Terrace, Blackdog, for which a new street name is required. The development is shown in the attached plan Appendix 1.
- 2.2 Belhelvie Community Council have chosen the name Booth Gardens. As they have chosen to name the street after a person '*Road Policy Note 9 – Street Naming and Property Numbering in Aberdeenshire*' states that the name should be approved by the relevant Area Committee.
- 2.3 Belhelvie Community Council have contacted Edna Booth to seek her approval to name the street after her. Mrs Booth who is 82, and a member of Blackdog Residents Association, stated that she is happy with the suggestion and would be honoured to have a street named after her.
- 2.4 The Ward 8 Members have been consulted on the name choice.
- 2.5 The Head of Finance and the Monitoring Officer within Business Services have been consulted and have no comments to make.
