Infrastructure Services (Gavin Penman)	<p>Last update to Committee for information:-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Repairs to the bund and Davidson Field, Port Elphinstone is complete. Scottish Water have given an undertaking to repair the bund on land owned by Scottish Water between Keithhall Road and the River Don. This will include reinstating the area of bund where there is flood damage near the treatment works, repairing rabbit damage, and covering the bund with topsoil. It is anticipated this work will take place in the next few months. Following liaison with the Kembhill Park Flood Defence and Resilience Group, we have procured a Water-Gate temporary flood barrier that can be deployed if flooding is expected. We expect deliver of this in the next few months. We are preparing the flood study tender for Inverurie & Port Elphinstone. It is expected this tender will be issued around March. <p>It is intended that an update will be provided to Councillors on a quarterly basis either through the Statement of Outstanding Business or on Ward Pages.</p> <p>Further information as at June 2017:-</p> <p>Councillor should note that SEPA and FPU will provide a seminar on Flooding to the Committee on 22 August 2017</p>
