

## REPORT TO MARR AREA COMMITTEE – 22 MAY 2018

### NAMING OF NEW STREETS, HILL OF BANCHORY, BANCHORY

#### 1 Recommendations

The Committee is recommended to:

**1.1 Agree to the street naming suggested by Banchory Community Council, that is Provost Webster Road and Clark Avenue.**

#### 2 Background / Discussion

- 2.1 The new development off Hill of Banchory South, Banchory requires the naming of streets that will serve the new sports centre, shop units and adjacent housing. The present development has two streets needing names and, in accordance with the Council's Policy for Street Naming and Numbering, the Community Council and the Local Members were consulted regarding the selection of suitable street names.
- 2.2 Banchory Community Council has suggested naming the streets after former councillors, with the proposed names for the streets being Provost Webster Road and Clark Avenue.
- 2.3 The former councillors, Jill Webster, Karen Clark and Linda Clark have been consulted and have given their approval for the use of their names in the naming of the streets in the development.
- 2.4 The Head of Finance and Monitoring Officer within Business Services have been consulted in the preparation of this report and had no comments to make and are satisfied that the report complies with the Scheme of Governance and relevant legislation.

#### 3 Scheme of Governance

- 3.1 The Committee is able to consider and take a decision on this item in terms of Section B.11.2.1 of the List of Committee Powers in Part 2A of the Scheme of Governance as it relates to determining proposed street names which are or were that of individual persons living or dead.
