An application round is ongoing to allocate funds already received, with a number of applications related to food and drink projects. A report is to be brought to Committee by October on Crown Estate funding which will set out how the funds have been used in Aberdeenshire.
2.	Roads Policy Review Update	10/03/2022	Community Based Variable Message Signs The Service would investigate a Code of Operation and a plan for implementation and report back to Committee.	Philip McKay	Consideration is being given to the most appropriate approach to ensure deployment of such infrastructure can safely achieve positive reductions in traffic speeds. We hope to be able to report back to Committee in late Autumn.
